What is a 'Special Occasion Permit'?

- A SOP is needed any time liquor is sold or served anywhere other than in a licensed establishment or a private place. A private place is an indoor area usually not open to the public and not open to the public during the time of your event (ie. A private residence, or office building)

How do I obtain a 'Special Occasion Permit' (SOP/Temporary Liquor License)?
